Nader, Adrian F., age 104, of Allendale, died on Tuesday, February 13th. Born in Springfield, Ohio, to the late Bertie and Lewis Nader, he was happily married to Martha (Raster) who pre-deceased him. He worked at New Lexington High School, teaching English from 1937 to 1943. At the outbreak of World War II, he applied for a commission in the Navy, and was accepted with the rank of Ensign. He served in the Pacific as communications officer on the USS Indus. After the war ended, he joined the faculty at Marietta College in Ohio, where he became assistant to the president. After ten years there, he received and accepted an offer to be the development director at Wagner College, Staten Island, NY. From there he and Martha moved to River Edge, and he became the Senior Editor of RN, a national magazine for nurses. He retired in 1974, and he and Martha enjoyed traveling.
