I can't tell you how many nights I've looked over and I can still see you there.. blankets a mess, hair standing up and just for a second things are alright again.

What I wouldn't do to see you again just one last time. To hold your hand, look into your eyes and kiss you. Every night we said the exact same thing to one another, "good night I love you". Every night before I go to sleep still I say it in my head or I say it out loud and I hope that you can hear me.

I will never truly say goodbye because as long as I'm alive you are as well. As long as your family and your friends think of you and have memories and laugh or smile, you're alive.

Time cannot take that from us Andrew. Time cannot take you from me. Our great love.

As you told me back in the summer of 1996 we were "made in heaven" and most days I actually believe that's where we will meet again.

“ I was walking my dog, depressed as usual. I had resisted leaving Chicago for more than two years, convinced that leaving would prove I was a failure. After 20 years as a free-lance writer, I was no longer making money. My sister had urged me to return to New York, but I knew it wouldn't work out. I finally relented, but she was constantly yelling at me for not having a full-time job. I had left New York nearly 30 years earlier because my mother yelled all day and now I was having flashbacks and nightmares.

As I walked my beagle, I saw a man who was roughly my age walking two hound dogs. The dogs introduced themselves to each other and the man introduced himself to me. Within a few days, Andrew Heitner was phoning me nearly every day to see when I was walking Susie. The five of us were soon walking together constantly.

Andrew was also regularly inviting me to his home, which was around the corner from my sister's home. For the next six months or so, I looked forward to every invitation to watch TV in his basement. Andrew made me feel more at home at his home than my mother and sister made me feel at theirs. I will never be able to fully express my gratitude for all those times we were together, but I can honestly say that his hospitality probably prevented my depression from spiraling completely out of control.

And he still regularly invited me to his home after I moved about 10 miles away.

Andrew's commitment to his family and friends was unparalleled.
