Anne Marie (Soto) Frater, 78, of Teaneck, NJ died October 2, 2024, just hours shy of her next birthday on October 3rd. Born to Ann Philipps Flood and Cornelius Joseph Flood Jr., Anne Marie grew up in Rochester, NY before moving to New York City to pursue her career.

Anne Marie earned a bachelor's degree in Home Economics from Cornell University and later went on to complete a Master's degree from New York University.

She married Albert Ronald Frater on June 1, 1982 and they had one child, Gabrielle.

After beginning her career in the home sewing industry, working for Butterick and Vogue Patterns, Anne Marie opened her own communications firm. Some of her many professional accomplishments include authoring several sewing-related books and publications, as well as several long-tenured roles as Editor-in-Chief of the American Sewing Guild's Notions newsletter, public relations consultant for the NJ chapter of the American Society of Interior Designers (ASID), and Executive Director of the Manhattan-based Retail

Marketing Society.

Anne Marie was an avid sewer, baker, and reader, often gifting handmade items to friends and family. She was also a longtime parishioner and lector at St. Anastasia's R.C. Church in Teaneck. Above all, she was a devoted mother and grandmother, taking great joy in spending time with her "girls."

Anne Marie is survived by her husband Albert Frater, daughter Gabrielle Scott, granddaughters Emerson and Ella Scott, and brother Cornelius Flood, as well as her six nieces and nephews and three grand-nephews.

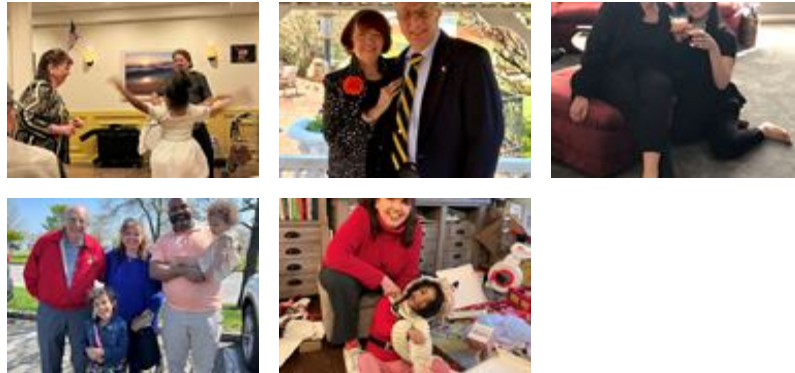
