



Bessie Mae Taste (nee Hilton)

Although her birth certificate reads 1932, Bessie Mae Taste (née Hilton) was actually born on April 5, 1931 in Manning South Carolina as the third child of Wheeler Hilton and Marie Rantin. She married Robert Taste and raised five children in Teaneck NJ. Robert, her husband of 51 years, died in 2006.

Bessie was a active member of Shiloh AME Zion Church in Englewood NJ, where she served as President and Secretary of the Church's Nurses Club. Bessie was also involved in the Church Women United Organization serving as Corresponding Secretary of their Englewood Chapter and was honored as Valiant Woman of the Year. Bessie retired from Holy Name Medical Center in Teaneck. She worked as a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) in the nursery for 47 years. She had previously worked as an LPN at Roper Hospital in Charleston SC and Jamaica Hospital in Queens NY.

Bessie is survived by two children, Luther "Kinlee" Taste and Ronnie Lee Taste. She is predeceased by her Sons Joseph "Willie" and Anthony Albert Taste and her Daughter Robsene "Budda" Brown. Bessie leaves behind several grandchildren. They are Joseph Jr., Michelle, Anthony Albert, Rita Victoria and Steven Frederick Wheeler Taste. Takicia Otero, Shontae Teaste and Kemadi Brown. She is predeceased by Granddaughter Kwana Brown. Bessie is survived by her Sisters Helen King, Betty Singletary and Lucille DeJesus. She has been predeceased by her Sisters Beulah Scott, Clara

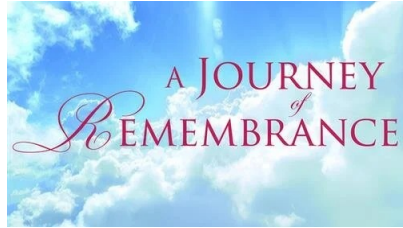

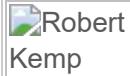

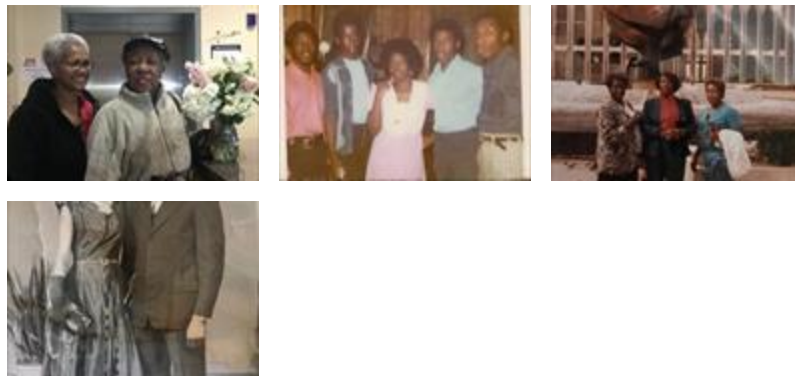
