Clare Florence Baker died on Saturday, February 8, 2025 after a brief illness with both congestive heart failure and Covid.

Clare was born in 1930 in the Bronx. When she was 4, her mother died and at 11, her father died, leaving Clare to be raised by her wonderful older sister, Marion. As young women, both Clare and Marion lived in a residence for women and worked in Manhattan. In 1954 Clare married. Subsequently, they lived in Bordentown, NJ, and Drexel Hill, PA, before settling in Teaneck in 1960, where she still lived at the time of her death.

Clare was predeceased by her parents, Anthony and Catherine Heubel, and by her brother, Richard, and her sister Marion.

Clare is survived by four children: Catherine (Bobby), Mary (Andy), Andrew (Adiba), and Charles, with whom she lived and who took such gentle, loving care of her; six grandchildren, and one great granddaughter; all the cousins in the Heubel-Shea families; many dear friends, and her beloved community of St. Anastasia Parish in Teaneck.

The Mass of the Resurrection will be celebrated for Clare on Saturday, February 15, at 11 AM in St. Anastasia, Teaneck, NJ. The wake, from 10 - 11 will precede the mass. Burial will immediately follow in George Washington

Memorial Park, Paramus, NJ.
