His lifelong struggle kept him on a roller coaster of his life experiences. A service will be held at 10 AM on Tuesday at the funeral home with burial to follow at George Washington Memorial Park Cemetery - Paramus, NJ. As a student he excelled at school in all subjects and dealt with his condition as a true hero. He was a moderator for bipolarworld.net where he helped and assisted others with the debilitating disease of depression. his life. Less fortunate people would have fallen at an earlier age, but he endured the challenge through consistent medical help and supportive family.
