GREENBLATT, David, 49, of Ridgefield Park (formerly Teaneck), passed away on February 22, 2017 from brain cancer.

Born in Somers Point, NJ. David was adopted by Beth and Theodore Greenblatt, and lived with them in Dover, NJ before moving to Teaneck, NJ during his high school years. David was a talented runner, participating in Cross- Country, Winter Track and Field teams. He won the North Jersey 1 Sectional Cross Country Championship Meets in 1984 & 1985. He remains the All Time Bergen County Performance List for his 3200m run in 1986.

A Teaneck high school graduate, he served in the Navy for four years. He studied electronics and became an expert troubleshooter. Over his career he worked at Atlantic Marine Electronics Inc., Creston Electronics Inc., Real Time Services, Video Corporation of America and most recently, VideoSonic Systems Inc.

David had an insatiable curiosity about how things worked. He loved science, learning, and loved to experiment. He baked and cooked, often making up recipes as he went along (and never wrote them down!).

David was a beloved husband and father. He is survived by his wife Marcy, and children Matthew, Duncan, Shannon, and Brianna. He is also survived by his siblings Edward Augsberger (Ksenia), Tammy Yoxheimer (Bill) and Nancy Boyd (Mike).

Memorial visitation will be on Sunday 1-5pm at Volk Leber Funeral Home, 789 Teaneck Rd., Teaneck.

Memorial service will commence at 4:30pm.
