Dennis Martin Maloney, 75, passed away peacefully at his home in Oradell, NJ, on January 2, 2022. He is survived by his beloved wife of 48 years, Susan (Toscano). Devoted father of Elizabeth Coleman and her husband, Al; Jennifer Cramer and her husband, Jason; and Matthew Maloney. Loving grandfather of Ryan and Caroline Coleman, and James Cramer.

Born in Hackensack, he was a proud alumni of Bergen Catholic High School and Fairfield University. After being drafted into the Vietnam War, he returned home and began his career as a CPA. He was a long time corporate accountant for Unilever/Best Foods until his retirement, and also ran a private practice serving as a personal accountant to many family and friends.

He was an active member of St. Joseph's R.C. Church in Oradell, serving for many years on the finance committee. He was also a proud Trustee and Assistant Treasurer for the Adopt-A-Soldier Platoon, an organization to which he happily dedicated much of his time and efforts during his retirement.

The family will receive friends and family on Thursday, January 6 from 3-6PM at Volk Leber Funeral Home, 268 Kinderkamack Rd., Oradell. A mass celebrating Dennis' life will be held at 10AM on Friday at St. Joseph's R.C.

Church in Oradell, with interment to follow at St. Joseph's Cemetery in Hackensack.
