



## Dorothy L. Horn

Dorothy Ann Horn passed away on the fifth of April, 2016 at CareOne in Teaneck. She was 89 years old and for the last 50 years had been a resident of Teaneck, NJ.

Born Dorothy Ann Lindemann on April 23, 1926 in Hackensack, NJ, she was the daughter of Dorothy (O'Connor) and Carl Lindemann, Sr., She attended Hackensack schools and Middlebury College, graduating in 1948. In 1965 Dorothy married Max Horn.

Dorothy and Max settled in Teaneck, NJ. Dorothy was a longtime and trusted employee of Jones & Jones, Attorneys at Law, in Hackensack, NJ, working as a Legal Secretary/Paralegal. She was hardworking and very well liked.

Dorothy and Max would spend summers in Nantucket, enjoying their time there by reading, cycling around the island, and relaxing at the beach. Dorothy was also an avid knitter, follower of politics, and reader. She was interested in photography and always had a camera with her. Later in her life she regularly attended the Friday morning lecture series at the Teaneck Library and several times a week would go to the Glenpointe Spa & Fitness Center for a swim and a walk on the treadmill. She would also regularly walk up to Teaneck Road and catch a bus into New York City, where she would take in a show or go to the symphony or the Macy's Flower Show. Dorothy was a great conversationalist, and stayed in contact with family and the many friends she made and kept over the years.

In the last few years of her life Dorothy was lovingly cared for by a wonderful

team of caregivers who enabled her to live out her life in the comforts of her own home.

Dorothy was preceded in death by her husband Max, her parents, her brother Carl Lindemann, Jr., and her sister Catherine Lindemann. She leaves nieces and nephews, grandnieces and grandnephews, and her beloved cat Nellie. Family and friends are invited to visit on Saturday from 11-1pm at Volk Leber Funeral Home, 789 Teaneck Road Teaneck, NJ.

Funeral service will commence at 1pm.

Interment will follow at George Washington Memorial Park Cemetery, Paramus, NJ with her beloved husband Max.
