Edith Carol Barnette died on April 24, 2017 in Leonia, NJ after a courageous battle with cancer. Carol was born August 1, 1945 at Gadsden Memorial Hospital in Quincy, FL to Thomas Ralph Barnette and Mary Frank Barnette, who predeceased her.

Carol grew up in Tallahassee and was a member of the Florida High Class of 1963. She attended Florida State University and was briefly married to O.A. "Bookie" Kitchings of Bainbridge, GA. Carol later obtained a B.A. in English from The City College of New York. Carol lived and worked in New York City for many years, before retiring to live on Lake Lindy in West Milford, NJ.

Carol is survived by sisters June Barnette Sands of Tallahassee, Mary Barnette Waldeck of West Milford, NJ, nephew Thomas Sands of Tallahassee, niece Valerie Sands Weeks (John) of Tallahassee, niece Erika "Rycki" Waldeck (Brad Ilowit) and great nephew Wiley Ilowit, all of Leonia, NJ.

An accomplished musician, Carol played the French horn for both the National Symphony and the American Ballet Theatre and traveled all over the U.S. and the world during her career. Later in life she worked at the Museum of Natural History Magazine as an editor, and still later, was a free-lance editor. She was active in the French Bulldog Rescue Network and was instrumental in saving and enriching the lives of many dogs.

Carol brought joy to all of those who knew her with her kind spirit, thoughtful ways and sense of humor. She loved her family, dogs, all children, the beach, books, butterflies and all living things. A celebration of her life will be held in NJ on Saturday, April 29th.
