He was born in Duryea, PA where he graduated as Valedictorian of his High School class. He was admitted to Rutgers University School of Engineering with an academic scholarship, and graduated with the Class of 1944 after the war.

In 1943 he joined the U.S. Army and attended Officer's Training School, serving in the Philippines and Japan for three years. He was decommissioned as a First Lieutenant with an Honorable Discharge. He was accepted into the Cadet Training Program at P.S.E. & G., and rose through the ranks to the title of Division Manager.

He was President of the Oradell Swim Club for four years and President of the Public Service Speakers Forum at P.S.E. & G. As an avid golfer and member of the Hole-in-One Club, he served on several committees at Hackensack Golf Club where he was a long standing member.
