



## Eileen Drew Kennedy

August 11, 1936 - April 19, 2023

Eileen Drew Kennedy, a beloved mother, grandmother, sister, and friend, passed away peacefully at home on April 19th, 2023, at the age of 86. Eileen was born in New York City in 1936 to James & Margaret Drew, and was known throughout her life for her kindness, generosity, lively intellect, and great spirituality.

Eileen's commitment to helping others began at St. Vincent's School of Nursing, where she received her nursing degree. She continued her education at Columbia University, where she received both an undergraduate and master's degree in nursing education.

In 1961, Eileen married Arthur Kennedy, Jr., the love of her life, and they shared 52 years of marriage before he preceded her in death. Eileen's family was everything to her, and she was cherished by her four children, Susan, Arthur (Caridad Sierra), Joanne (Bill Bunker), and Karen (Paul Wright), and her grandchildren, Jessica, Allison, Sarah, and Arthur Aidan. Eileen is also survived by her sister and brother, Sheila Drew, and William (Laura) Drew, and brother-in-law, Donald (Mary Angela) Kennedy, as well as many beloved nieces, nephews, cousins, and long-held friends who Eileen embraced as family. Eileen is preceded in death by her sister, Patricia, and her sisters-in-law, Eleanor (Jim) Kennedy and Patricia (Edgar) Tonna.
