Evelyn Diaz, 62, of Bogota, NJ, went to be with the Lord on Sunday, April 19, 2015, at home with her family by her side.

Evelyn was born February 28, 1953 in New York City where she was raised by her mother, Mrs. Monserrate Vargas and her big brother Henry. Evelyn grew up in NYC surrounded by her 5 aunts and many cousins. She graduated from Morris HS in 1971 and continued her education at Hunter College, majoring in Art and Early Education. Evelyn came to know the Lord in 1975 at Manhattan Bible Church. She met the late Robert P. Diaz Jr. while handing out tracts in the Inwood area and married him in July of 1978. They lived together in NYC for 15 years with their three children until his passing. She then relocated to Teaneck, NJ.

Evelyn was a hardworking and compassionate person. She began her career at Manhattan Christian Academy as an elementary school teacher. She then stayed home to raise her children before returning to work at NY Presbyterian Hospital for 11 years. In 2006 she moved on to work for New York Organ Donor Network where she found great joy in educating people about organ donation. Her compassion allowed her to help families with the donation process as they dealt with the difficulties of losing a loved one. Evelyn was well loved throughout her career.

Evelyn is survived by three adoring children: Keziah Diaz Francisco, Karen Diaz Alcantara, and Robert Diaz III; two grandchildren, Noel and Nathan Alcantara, and a loving brother Henry Vargas. She is already missed by her family, friends and coworkers.

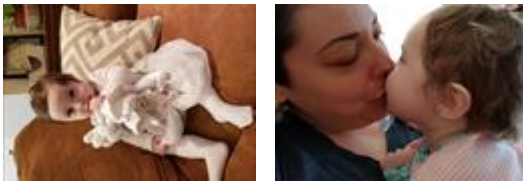
