As a grandfather, I have nothing but pleasant memories of him. He often let us assist him in his baking, he lined us up on the kitchen counter, and taught us how to knead and shape dough for ensaymada. he always made a homemade apple pie after we went apple picking. He rarely raised his voice.

He lived a long and full life that anyone could be envious of.

Grandpa, I still haven't fully come to grips that you won't be coming home with us after mass. i still feel like I'll see you sitting on the couch with your winter hat on and a big smile on your face.

But although you aren't physically here with us anymore, your legacy lives on through the lives that you've touched. Baking ability in Uncle Rey, Ingenuity in Uncle Ely, Patience in my mom, Felma, sense of humor in uncle junior, and intelligence with tita millet. The list goes on and on, but what i'm most thankful for is how you showed us what it truly meant to love
