Gordon was a veteran of the Vietnam War and graduated from Bentley College with a Bachelor of Science degree in Accounting.

Upon his return from the service, he started working with Union Carbide as a Programmer. He later moved to Blue Cross & Blue Shield where he worked managing their data center for 15 years until his retirement in 2000, at the ripe ole' age of 57 years young.
