



## Harriman Joseph

April 24, 1953 - January 14, 2026

Harriman Joseph, (Joe) passed away peacefully on January 14th, 2026, surrounded by his family in Teaneck, NJ. Joe was born on April 24th 1953 in Enmore, Guyana to Marine Joseph (Uncle Man Man) and Bhudia Joseph (Auntie Muniya). His siblings were Norman Joseph, Ronald Joseph (Raymond), Everne Boodhoo (Sylvie), Kenard Joseph (Ken), Rena Williams (Shelo), Devika Manku, and Marina Joseph.

He attended Enmore Government Primary School before enrolling in Tutorial High School. Cricket was very important to Joe and he started his cricket career at Encome Cricket Club.

Joe showed exceptional cricketing talent from an early age. By age 15, he represented Guyana in the Benson & Hedges competition against other Caribbean teams, and at 16, he distinguished himself against a visiting British schoolboys team with a well-applauded score of 78 runs. At 17, he competed in the Case Cup for the East Coast team, participated in trials for the Guyana national side, and scored a match-winning half-century in the Jones Cup (Demerara vs. Berbice). In 1973, aged 20, he left Guyana to pursue cricket in England before relocating to the United States, where he continued his career batting in the fourth position.

Joe met his wife, Sandy, in the 1980s, and they were married on August 24th, 1985. In 1991, they welcomed their son, Chadwick. Throughout this period, he continued to play cricket while building a career in real estate.

In his personal life, Joe enjoyed cooking, entertaining, and playing golf. Joe loved traveling and spending time with his friends and loved ones. He especially loved holidays with his family.

He is survived by his wife of 40 years, Sandy, their son Chad, his siblings; Ken, Sylvie and Devika. A celebration of Joe's life will be held on January 17th after the funeral. In lieu of flowers, the family requests donations to St. Jude's Children's Hospital or the American Cancer Society.
