After serving in the Navy, Harvey began his career as a Merchant Marine with US Lines, sailing on the passenger ships USS America and USS United States. As a merchant marine, he aided US forces during the Vietnam War by sailing supplies and cargo to various ports of call in the region. Harvey went on to become a sailing master, earning an unlimited Master's License and the designation of Captain. Captain Terwilliger retired after serving nearly 40 years at sea. Captain Terwilliger was a member of the International Organization of Masters, Mates & Pilots, The Propeller Club, The Destroyer Escort Sailors Association, and various other maritime organizations and groups.
