Hedda Ribolow, Ph.D., 73, of Teaneck, NJ, formerly of Brooklyn, Chicago, and Portland, OR, died June 2 in hospital, from results of a chronic illness. Devoted wife of Neal Rosenau, loving mother to Josh, fiercely proud grandmother of Miles, she is also survived by beloved sisters Irene Leff and Naomi Berman of Commack. After graduating from Abraham Lincoln High School in Brooklyn, Hedda's career in biochemistry research included college at Syracuse University, a Masters from Brooklyn College with research at Kings County Hospital, doctoral and post-doctoral work at the University of Chicago and University of Illinois-Chicago, and research at Reed College. She helped found the Chicago Womens Liberation Union, and was active in Science for Vietnam and Science for the People. In Portland, she worked with community groups to renovate city parks. In Teaneck, she helped create a pathway along the Hackensack River and served on the steering committee of Bergen Grassroots. She expressed her passion for the arts through membership in a range of cultural organizations, and was especially active with the Metropolitan Museum of Art and arts classes at the Teaneck Senior Center. She also served on the Teaneck Community Gardens Committee, having used the community garden since 1991. She was an agent with Russo Real Estate. She was Northern New Jersey representative of the University of Chicago Alumni Schools Committee, and worked with other parents of Horace Mann students to support the high school and its programs. A memorial service will be held in her honor on Saturday, June 8 at 1 pm, in the Volk-

Leber Funeral Home in Teaneck. The family is receiving visitors at their home in Teaneck, from 1-6 p.m. this week. In lieu of flowers, donations in her memory should be directed to the Metropolitan Museum of Art or to the Planned Parenthood Federation of America.
