Emanuel, Jane (nee Flanagan) 91, of New Milford, passed away December 28, 2015. Beloved wife of the late Stanley. Devoted mother of Michael and Charles. Cherished grandmother of seven, great-grandmother of six.

Jane joined the United States Army in October 1944 as a member of the General Wainwright Company of the Women's Army Corps. She served in the WACS until October 1946.
