Edward James (Jim) Walker, 74, passed away peacefully on March 5, 2020 surrounded by his loving family after a brief battle with cancer. Born in Syracuse, NY, Jim graduated from LeMoyne University in Syracuse. Jim worked for National Elevator Industry, Inc. from 1976 through 2002 where he served first as Labor Relations Manager and then as the long time Executive Director.
