Joan Patricia Oddie 86, of Teaneck passed away Thursday April 12, 2018 at CareOne Health Care facility in Oradell, NJ. Visitation is at Volk Leber Funeral Home, 789 Teaneck Road, Teaneck on Tuesday April 17th, from 6 to 8 pm and Wednesday April 18th, from 11am to 12:30pm.

Joan was born in Brooklyn NY and spent her childhood in Teaneck and is a graduate of Teaneck High School. In 1954 she married her first husband Edward P. Mathieson and moved to Hasbrouck Heights, NJ, where they raised their only child Edward Mathieson Jr. until Edward Sr's death in 1980. After marrying her current husband William John Oddie in 1988, Joan moved back to Teaneck where she spent the balance of her life until being admitted to CareOne just a few weeks ago.

Joan spent her over 30-year career at what is now Hackensack University Medical Center.
