PRISCO, JOAN L., (nee Saglimbene), 72, of Manahawkin, NJ formerly of Ringwood, NJ passed to the loving care of God on Friday, November 09, 2007 at home, after a battle with cancer for more than 18 years. Joan was born August 17, 1935, in Warren, PA to Lena and Philip Saglimbene, and spent much of her younger years in Warren. A graduate of Warren High School in Warren, PA, she continued her education and received her bachelors degree from Villa Maria College in Erie, PA., and her master's degree from New York University. Joan's career in education began as a teacher at Panama City High School in New York. Then she went on to be the Executive Secretary to President of the Julliard School of Music in New York City. After raising a family, she taught for a short time in the Cliffside Park school system, followed by a long career at Berkeley College, as a teacher and Dean. Joan was united in marriage to Fred Prisco on April 30, 1966. To this union, they were blessed with three sons, Fred, Philip and step-son Richard. They made their home in North Bergen for 6 years after which they moved to Ringwood, NJ in 1972 where they resided until 1996, when they moved to Manahawkin. Joan was predeceased by her father and mother, Philip and Lena (Cardman) Saglimbene of Warren, PA., and her son Philip in 1987.
