John Donald Davis, Sr., 91, passed away at home surrounded by his family on Sunday, May 17, 2020. He was born July 23, 1928 to Robert and Roselyn (Crosson) Davis in Fernandina Beach, FL. On October 3, 1951 he married Consuelo Verdelle Pinado at St. Anthony of Padua Roman Catholic Church in the Bronx, NY.

John is survived by 11 of his 13 children, Joseph (Bernadene) Davis, John (Robert) Davis, Jr., Maria (Al) Green, Nafisa Sharriff, Consuelo Davis, Angela Davis, Michael Davis, Christopher Davis, Christina Davis, Mark Davis and Emilie Davis, many loving grand and great grandchildren, and his brother Edwin (Dorothy) Davis. He was preceded in death by his loving wife of 36 years, Consuelo, their eldest daughter, Elizabeth Strother and infant son Anthony Davis.

John served as a corporal in the United States Army during the Korean War, and was a dedicated employee of the United States Postal Service for 40 years following the war. He was a key player on the GPO softball team for most of his years with the Postal Service. John was a faith-filled Catholic gentleman who loved family above all else and was known as "Papa John" by nearly everyone who met him. He also loved sports -- baseball, softball, and golf (which he played up until the end), and loved to cook for his extended family and friends.

“As I think back on all the years that I have known the Davis’ (and there are a lot of years) I have so many fond memories of the earliest years when Joe and I first became “bosom buddies” in high school. He and I spent many Saturday nights exploring the City and because it was too late to travel alone we’d have to pick one house to spend the night. His was closer, but it did require traveling through the notorious South Bronx to the projects on Webster Avenue. The Davis apartment with Mrs. Davis and 12 1 (me) was my second home. As many of you may know husband/father, Mr John Davis, worked for the US Postal Service until he retired, so he often was not home on those nights that I spent in their home. He worked the graveyard shift when the hourly wage was time-and half a differential – a decision that I am sure he made to provide the most for his family.

There are three things that I know about my surrogate dad: (1) He loved the Lord with his whole heart, soul, and mind; (2) He loved his family and would do anything for them; and (3) He was an inspiration to many of us. This last one I want to say was the most precious one to me, and maybe to his children, grands, and great grands. I often would ask him what is the secret to raising 12 kids in the South Bronx and have all of them become college educated, contributing adults to our society? He would say prayer and faith. But he would also add teaching them to do the right thing. He was a special man who lead by example, living a good Christian life, honoring his word, and making this last place that he left a better place for all of us.

I am going to miss our annual Lakers, Clippers, and sometimes Dodger games together, your oxtails recipe, and the warmth of your smile. You have been my inspiration for a lifetime! RIP my dear Papa. RIP! You’ve earned your place that He has prepared for you in His House!
