John served for six years in the United States Navy during WWII and was honorably discharged as a Fire Controlman, Second Class. He received a World War II Victory Medal, American Area Campaign Medal, Asiatic-Pacific Campaign Medal, and a Good Conduct Medal. John served on the USS Indiana, Tolman, Davison, Carmick, and Moale. In 1950, John was recalled into service for the Korean War. Upon discharge from the service, he joined the New Milford Police Department as a patrolman and retired as Lieutenant. John was a member of the American Legion Post 217 and Veteran's of Foreign Wars Post in New Milford and the American Legion Post of North Haledon.
