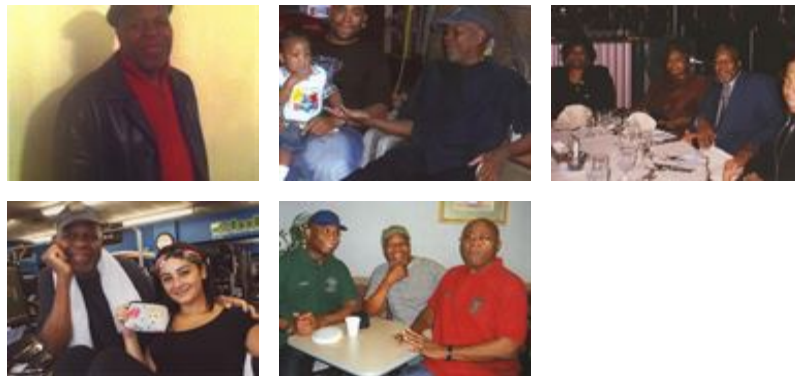
He always had a gentle (and often funny) way of consoling us no matter how badly we did and while the team will continue, things will never be the same.
