He pre-deceased her on November 17, 2000. On his birthday, August 8th, she began her transition and now reunited with him in glory.

To that union, they had 7 children - Wendy Lucas (Raymond), Ruth Lynch, Isaac Lynch, Jr. , Gloria Lynch, all of Englewood, Dolores Glover (Melvin), Angel Grant of Charlotte, North Carolina, and Christie Taylor (Eural B.) of
