Marlene Teresa Harvey was born on April 20, 1943 to Adele Eure and Curtis Edwards SR. She attended the Nyack Public School System where she began her pursuit of a career in medicine by becoming a member of the Future Nurses of America. Teresa, to family and friends, obtained her nursing degree from Rockland Community College, a Master's Degree from Hunter College and her Doctorate from Long Island University. She was a Professor of Nursing and taught at several Universities and Colleges including LIU and York College. She also held numerous positions at Northshore LIJ and Columbia Presbyterian. She was a consummate professional who appeared in the Book of Who's Who of People with Outstanding Accomplishment. In 1997 she founded the Michael Anthony Bullock Foundation for Education and Research in honor of her son who predeceased her. She is also predeceased by her parents; brothers Tyrone and Ronald Edwards, and stepfather Garfield Carter. She leaves to cherish her memory her granddaughter Valencia Bullock; brothers; Curtis Edwards JR, Larry Edwards, Gary and Kenneth Carter and a host of cousins, nieces and nephews.

I will always remember when we first traveled the long passenger train route to New York City and Nyack, NY on a Union Pacific Zepher passenger train, as kids. My older brother "Albert Jr." was twelve (12), I, "Harry" was ten (10) years, and my younger brother, "Darryl", was about eight (8) years old and "Tyrone" was about three (3),- (He was too young for the trip), to see our Grandmother, Louise Katherine Eure Jackson and our Great Grandmother Mollie White Coker in Harlem, NY. Although, a few days shortly after we had arrived in Grand Central Station, my Grandmother was so determined to make sure we saw all the top tourist sites, with her travel friend, a Mr. Falls; like "The Empire State Building, "The Museum of Natural Art and History", "The Statue of Liberty", "The Bronx Zoo", "Times Square, "The Rockefeller Center, "Broadway, "Coney Island", and to Long Island Sound to visit our Aunt Claudia (Eure) Parker and her husband Harry Parker. She later took us to Nyack to visit family Aunt Neva, Aunt Clarine Milton, Uncle Alex Eure, Uncle Floyd Eure and family. Aunt Mavis Eure Keno and husband, Mr. Keno and family of four (4) daughters, Marvia, Clarice, Paula, and Andrea were not in NY at the time, since Aunt Mavis and Uncle Keno and their kids were all living in Indiana. But then, when we went to see Aunt Adele's and Uncle Garfield Carter's and their family home in Nyack; that's when all of our "Great Family Kids Fun" started. We met "Sonny" Curtis, Marlene "Teresa", Larry, Ronnie, Tyrone, Gary, and Kenny, and (maybe) Tyrone, and other family and friends. We swam in their pools, played football, jumped on trampolines, skated, and went up to and hiked at "Bear Mountain" and camped overnight in the Pochinoes . We "had a ball", with so much fun and memorable times with our new found cousins, in New York. We all knew and could see, even then, that "Theresa" was smart! She seemed to be very science proficient and scholarly focused. It seemed clear that she would certainly pursue such a stellar career in the field of Nursing and medical instruction. This was certain.

After several later business related and family visits, I learned that she started and founded a medical research foundation in memory of her son, Michael, who had passed away at a very young age due to a very rare disease, for which her Research Foundation, in the name of her son, "Michael Bullock" was established. When she hosted and helped facilitate one of our "Eure, Smith, Collins Family Reunion" several years ago, in Norfolk, VA ; "Theresa" orchestrated and conducted

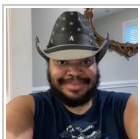
