“ Dear Dempsey Family,

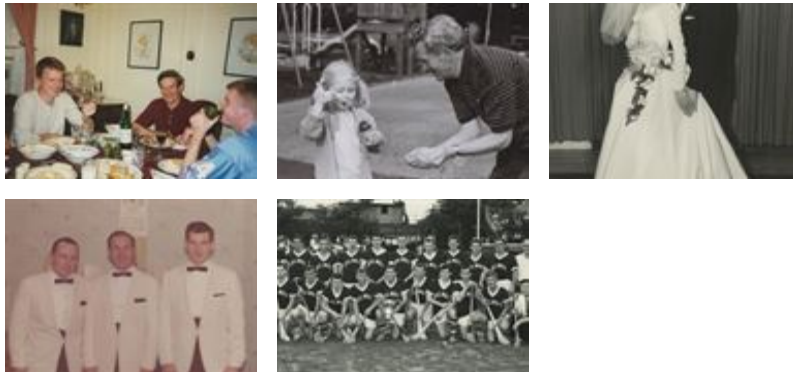
