I met 'Nelson' in April of 1971 at his mom and dad's home on Ardsley Pl. in Teaneck. A mutual friend (Butch C) had taken me there and introduced us. You see, Nelson was a highly accomplished electric bassist; an instrument in which I had become interested in, and had only just started to learn to play that same year.

So Butch had taken me there to hear Nelson play. Well... it seems that Nelson had just done a gig the night before; his large "Guild Thunderbass" amp still in the livingroom as evidence. Nelson walked over to me, shook my hand, and said... "So you're the bass player that I've been hearing about..." I stuttered... "Yeah, but I just started a month ago!"

Nelson put on a record by Roberta Flack called, "Gone". I'd heard the song before, but when Nelson started to play along... I became a fan; of the song, of the bass, and of his! I'd never heard a real bass player play along in a livingroom before! Something happened to me when I witnessed him playing so fluently and accurately!

Long story short... I did go on to play the bass professionally with several "Name artists", And I still play to this day (44 yrs later!). But I wish Nelson were here so that I could tell him how much he had influenced me to do it; and I love him for that! ("Thank you sooo much Nelson: you will be missed!")
