BEIN, Nina (nee Kane), of Teaneck, passed away Monday, October 13, 2014. Nina was born in Brooklyn, NY to Josephine Berg Kane and Dr. Arthur P. Kane in 1931. She graduated from James Madison High School in Brooklyn and then Wellesley College, after which she worked for advertising giant J. Walter Thompson on Madison Avenue. She met Donald Bein while taking graduate classes at New York University, where he was a Ph.D. candidate. Following their marriage in 1960 they moved to Teaneck, where Donald taught mathematics, and later computer science, at Fairleigh Dickinson University. They lived together on Trafalgar Street until Donald's death in 2000, raising two sons, Eric and Bob, and three dogs, Max, Boffin, and Watson. An avid walker and opinionated conversationalist, Nina was well known and well liked in her Teaneck neighborhood. Nina was a voracious reader, especially of mystery novels, and frequented multiple public libraries throughout Bergen County. She maintained her passionate support of the New York Mets, and her passionate opposition to the New York Yankees, to the end of her life.

Nina is survived by her sons, Eric (Jessica), of Voorheesville, NY, and Bob (Betsy), of Littlestown, PA, and four grandsons, Charley, Will, Jordan, and Andrew.
