

Paul Saint-Aime

March 31, 1934 - September 19, 2023

Paul is survived by his son Carl Saint-Aimé, his daughters Pascale Thomas (née Saint-Aimé), Johanne Rateau (née Saint-Aimé), and Marjorie Barthelus (née Saint-Aimé), his sons-in-law Eddy Thomas and Bertho Barthelus, his grandchildren Marie-Sybille Rateau, Emilie Thomas, Victoria Thomas, Jean-Sebastien Rateau, and Olivier Barthelus.

Paul was born in Pernier, Haiti on March 31, 1934 to Benoit and Victoire Saint-Aimé, the youngest of five siblings. He was married for 41 years to Marie Denise Saint-Aimé (née Denis) until her passing in 2012. He held multiple higher education degrees, including in Agronomy, Bookkeeping & Accounting, and Economics & Applied Sciences. His early career was devoted to non-profit, humanitarian work with USAID to bring sustainable farming at scale in his beloved native land. He later founded the country's first herbal tea company, FLOHASA, then went on to be a public servant as the general secretary to the Haitian Minister of Finance. Paul immigrated to the United States in 1992, where he continued his career working for the Equitable Life Insurance Company. He retired from New York City's Human Resources Administration in 2009.

In retirement, Paul pursued his passion for oil painting on canvas. As a member of New York's Salmagundi art club, he often exhibited his art, including in the community of Oradell. One of his paintings, "The three horsemen" earned an honorable mention at an art competition. He was also a prolific writer; in 2020 he published "Credo", a testimony to his catholic faith.

A funeral service will be held on Saturday, September 23, 2023. Viewing at Volk-Leber funeral home from 9:00-10:30 AM will be followed by mass at 11:00 AM at Saint-Joseph Church in Oradell, NJ.

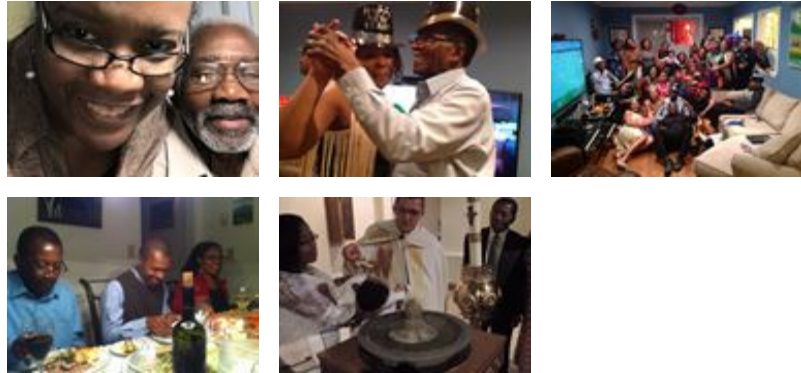
