Robert Francis O'Neill, 71, passed away May 2, 2018 with family by his side. Bob was born to Margaret and William on Feb 6, 1947 in Jersey City, NJ. He graduated from Teaneck High School in 1965 and was in the Army from 1966-1968, during which time he was deployed to Vietnam and was awarded a Bronze Star Medal. When Bob returned home to Teaneck, NJ he worked for the Post Office before joining the Teaneck Fire Department, where he would spend the next 40 years, rising to the rank of Deputy Chief. Bob retired to Long Branch, NJ, where he enjoyed drinking coffee, reading the paper, and listening to New York Yankees games on the radio while sitting on his balcony overlooking the ocean. Bob is survived by five children: Michael-Ann, Allison, Sean, Meghan-Rose, and Alexander. He is also survived by four grandchildren and his wife of 23 years, Patricia.
