



## Theresa Jones

December 11, 1945 - December 20, 2022

Irene Theresa Jones, 77, of Cinnaminson, NJ, Passed away on December 12, 2022, 1 day after her birthday. Born on December 11, 1945, to Arthur and Lucille Stubbs in Metropolitan Hospital NYC, Theresa was baptized into the Roman Catholic Faith and had her first communion at Our Lady of Lourdes, NYC on November 25, 1952. In her early years she lived in New York, attending St. Agnes grammar school followed by Girls High School, both in Brooklyn, NY. She received a certificate in Computer Programming and continued to work her way through the ranks of the United States Post Office finally becoming a system software specialist where she worked for 31 years before retiring in 2008. Theresa was a Teaneck resident for 25 years, during her time there she was a parishioner of St. Anastasia's Church where she assisted as an altar server, catechist, Bowery Mission Team Member, and various other duties. After moving down to Cinnaminson, NJ Theresa became a parishioner and active Vincentian of St. Charles Borromeo Church. In her parish she was a core member of the intake team, a group that makes first contact with neighbors in need, Theresa devoted her time to shopping, preparing, and delivering loving meals with the group. Theresa passed away with the family by her side after a courageous battle against neuroendocrine cancer. She is survived by her husband of 38 years Meville Jones, daughter Tanya Turner, son Raymond Turner and daughter in law Diana Gay, furbaby Autumn the Puggle, Stepsons Adam & David Jones, Cousins Geraldine Bronson & Sandra Jones, The Sharpe Family which includes her goddaughter

Tanya Sharpe, Godson Jonelle Brothers, and a multitude of extended family, close friends, and colleagues.

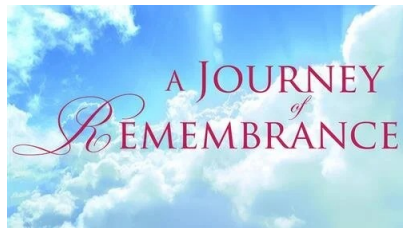

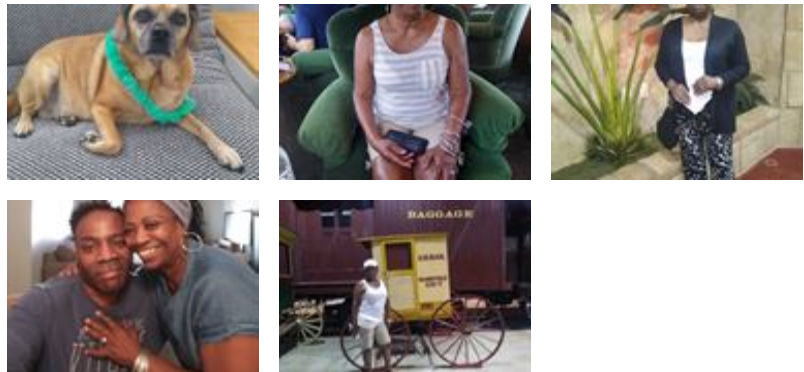
