Thomas H. Blehl, 95, passed away on June 13, 2020. Tom was born to Louis and Mary Blehl in Brooklyn, New York. Beloved husband of Camille for the last 41 years, and to Elinor, who predeceased him in 1976, for 29 years. Tom is survived by 11 of his 12 children: Mary, Thomas, Stephen, Vincent, Constance, Elinor, John, Andrea, Erica, Allen and Kathleen; 11 grandchildren; and 9 great-grandchildren.
