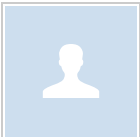

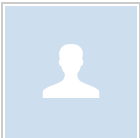

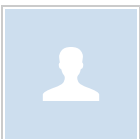

“ I can't tell you how sorry I was to hear of Victor's passing. I worked for Victor, John and Richie when they owned Pignoli's Restaurant in Franklin Lakes back in 1985-6. I was 15/16 years old. I believe my mother, who was in real estate at the time, helped them with the purchase of the business.

It feels somewhat trite to say this, but I'll say it anyway... he was a truly great guy. A solid guy.

We all have instances that stand out in the memories of our youth. I do have to say though, that I have a disproportionate amount of memories that stand out during that time of my life when it comes to Victor.

I not only worked for him at the restaurant, but I also interned for him one summer at his law office in Hackensack. Since I didn't have my drivers license at the time, he would drive me home after work.

I think Victor was one of the smartest, wittiest, and funniest people I have ever known. Now being smart, witty, and funny is great, but combine that with being a very generous and caring person as well, and you have someone who forever occupies a place in your memory and your heart.

Funny story... Victor drove me home from the restaurant one wintery night in his black, classic Saab (turbo, I have to say turbo, because he loved the fact that it was a subtle looking but kick ass car). Rounding a sharp right hand bend on Colonial Road, we slid, grazing a garbage truck that was coming the other direction. It was only a minor accident and we were both totally fine, but he turned to me immediately after, pointing his finger in my face and said in a well, mostly funny way, "You tell your parents NOTHING about this!" Scared shitless of course, I didn't tell my parents anything about the accident. I do believe, though, that he did actually have the car fixed at my father's auto body shop in Jersey City, funny enough :-).

What I will always remember about Victor was his kindness, his sense of humor, his willingness to be there for and support you, and... come one now, you know what I'm talking about... his great laugh!!! Was it a laugh or a cackle??? It was always a belly laugh, I guess you could say a belly cackle.

A truly a great guy, and I will always remember him fondly.

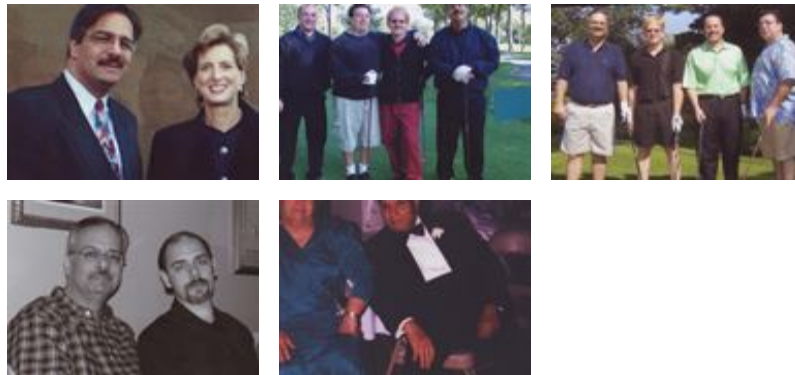
