“ I just learned of Brownie's passing after 7 o'clock tonight. If I lived closer I would have come to pay my high respects for such a wonderful man. He was such a compassionate and caring person. He treated each customer how he would like to be treated or how he would want others to treat his family. He was always so proud and joyful when speaking about his family. I was one of 3 sisters from the McLellan family who worked for Brownie in his pharmacy. He was the first person I knew to own a computer and taught me to data entry important information for each patient. He predicted that in the future all businesses would use computers. His competitors laughed at him, but he was a true visionary. He had a thirst for knowledge and was always on the cutting edge of medical information. He knew that Starry Night by Vincent Van Gogh was my favorite image, so he took me to the Museum of Modern Art in NY to see the actual painting! He used to get a big kick out of seeing customers get confused when my sister Mary (Monica to him) and I (Judy Jail) were working together. We looked very much alike and customers would wonder why I didn't know what they were talking about when they had just explained something a little while before (but it was actually Mary they had spoken with). He was always the go-to person for my Mother whenever we had any kind of medical crisis. His knowledge and caring made him an invaluable resource. I often stopped to see him when I returned to Bergenfield--even if just for a few minutes with 4 or 5 children in tow. Sending my heartfelt sympathy to Mrs. Browning and the whole family.
