Wes (Werner Eric) Stumpf, 76, of Mahopac, New York, died on Monday July 28, 2014, in Bronx, New York, after a long battle with cancer. Wes was born on December 25, 1937, in Newark, New Jersey, to Frederick and Elly Stumpf. Wes grew up in Irvington, New Jersey, and graduated from Irvington High School in 1955. Wes received three college degrees, a B.S. in Mathematics from Rutgers University, an M.S. in Math and Programming Science from New York University, and an M.Ph. in Electronics and Computer Engineering from Syracuse Univ. Wes spent a long career as a senior programmer and architect with IBM both in New York and in Minnesota. Dad raised his first family in Wappingers Falls, NY, and his second family in Patterson, NY. After retirement, he kept busy as a consultant teaching computer programming, substitute teaching at local schools, and with his second career as an airport transportation business operator. Wes also had a great affinity for the New York Yankees. At times during his life, Wes loved to camp, fish, play tennis and racquetball, raise small farm animals, and spend time outdoors.

He is survived by his life partner, Janis Massa, from Bronx, New York. He is also survived by his children, Lisa Willaman and her husband Rick from Austin, TX, Greg Stumpf, from Norman, OK, Jeanne Stumpf, from Camp Hill, PA, Kris Schmidt-Stumpf, from Madison, WI, and a granddaughter, Audrey Stumpf, also from Norman, OK. He was preceded in death by his father, Frederick Stumpf, and his mother, Elly (Gorenzel) Stumpf. He is also survived

by his brother, Frederick Stumpf and his wife, Carole, from Corolla, NC and Paradise Township, PA, and their two children, Janet and Rick.

Wes always said, "Let's let the past be the past and just concentrate on what we have today". He was a man who lived for today. The world lost a truly kind and gentle soul today who we all had the honor of knowing and spending time with.
