Willa Cherot, a long time resident and community organizer in Englewood, NJ, passed away peacefully in her home on March 6th, 2025 at the age of 101. She was born in Philadelphia and raised in New York City where she had an acclaimed career as a model, actress and business owner.

Willa was devoted to the town of Englewood. During her time in the community she ran the Jazz Club, Willa's Supper Club on N Van Brunt St, organized the town's first neighborhood watch group to keep the streets safe, and assisted multiple mayors jumpstart their careers.

Willa had 3 loving children, the Honorable Joseph Clark who served as a judge in Englewood for over 30 years, Walter P Clark who was Captain of Englewood Fire Department for 26 years and Arba Clark who built and ran her own successful business on Martha's Vineyard.

Her memory will be cherished by her surviving grandchildren, Walter Holliday, Arba Marte, Erik Wildanger, Jamie Wildanger and Anna Clark.
