Dunleavy, William Raymond, who dedicated his life to the well-being of his family, died Monday evening at his home in Hackensack, NJ, at age 91.

William was born in July 1925 to James Dunleavy, a police officer, and his wife Florence, who lived in Jamaica, Queens, NY. William met his wife of 56 years, Viola Schwebinski of the Bronx, while they were both working in Manhattan. The newlyweds moved to Levittown on Long Island, where the first of their three children, James Vincent, was born. The couple soon moved to Syosset, where they had two daughters, Maryann and Jane Marie.

William went to work as a Purchasing Agent for Volkswagen of America in Englewood Cliffs in the mid-1960's and the family relocated, first living in New Milford, NJ, and then buying a house in Oradell.

After their children grew up and moved out, William and Viola moved to Atlantic City. They returned to northern New Jersey 12 years ago and settled in Hackensack.

William was preceded in death by Viola in 2010. He is survived by his three children and James's wife, Ann.

A visitation will be held for William at Volk Leber Funeral Home, 268 Kinderkamack Road, Oradell, NJ from 7-9 PM this Thursday evening. A

prayer service will be held 11 AM Friday at the funeral home with burial to follow at George Washington Memorial Park in Paramus.
